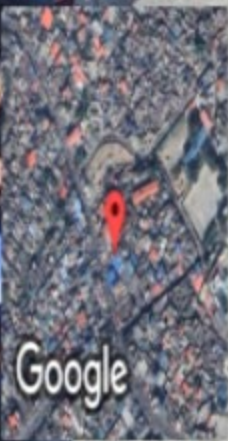








 **GPS Map Camera**
