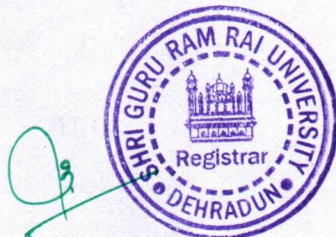

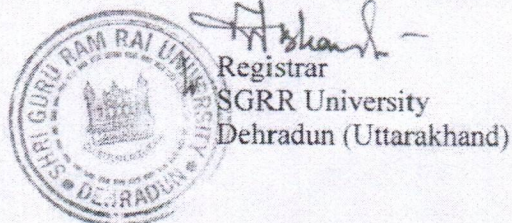
It is therefore requested that information/compliance as submitted above may kindly be accepted for grant of 2(f) status under UGC Act, 1956 to the SGRR University.

1.	The University should also work towards strengthening of its research capacity.	<p>The University strongly believes in strengthening of its existing research ecosystem/capacity. Forging of various Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with reputed research organizations is a step towards this. MoU with following organizations have been inked in last one year (February 2018- February 2019) (Enclosure-I).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Himalayan University Consortium (HUC), Kathmandu, Nepal (ii) Uttarakhand Science Education & Research Centre (USERC), Dehradun (iii) All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Rishikesh (iv) Uttarakhand State Council of Science and Technology (UCOST), Dehradun (v) Govind Ballabh Pant University of Agriculture & Technology, Pantnagar, Udham Singh Nagar (vi) Tribhuvan University, Nepal (vii) Agriculture and Forestry University, Nepal <p>Various research activities are in pipeline in collaboration with these organizations. Successful conduct of a conference on 23rd - 24th February, 2019 in association with one of the collaborators- Uttarakhand Science Education & Research Centre (USERC) justifies our commitment to strengthen our existing research capacity and create newer opportunities (Enclosure-II), Also being a member University of Himalayan University Consortium (HUC) - a consortium of 62 world class Universities, vast avenues and opportunities have opened for students and teachers of Shri Guru Ram Rai University, which will be gradually encashed in times to come. The university has an active Research Committee which is diligently working towards creation of a vibrant research culture. Four meetings have been thus convened with an aim to enrich the research ambience. Initiation of Ph. D. programs in 27 disciplines, creation of 257 seats has set the tone and research capacity of University is gaining due momentum. Twice a year Research Entrance Test (RET) is conducted to screen the best of brains for carrying exceptional, community oriented research studies at the various schools/ departments of the university. Research funding worth Rs 44,30000 /-has been granted to the various departments/Schools of University from Uttarakhand State Council of</p>



		<p>Science and Technology (UCOST), Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) & Department of Science & Technology (DST) Government of India (Enclosure-III). The university is keenly monitoring & navigating its research flow in the right prospective and various new projects are in pipeline for seeking grants from funding agencies.</p> <p>With a futuristic vision, the University envisages to focus on, in particular, regional issues in research-Traditional & folklore medicinal plants, organic farm produce, ecological issues, mountain studies to name a few. Development of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) cell to facilitate patenting, consultancy and technology transfer is also foreseen.</p>
2.	<p>University should expedite the process of obtaining at least one NCC Unit.</p>	<p>University understands the importance of imparting holistic education and grooming smart, compassionate and disciplined citizens for tomorrow. NCC helps in imparting such traits and procedural formalities had been initiated in 2017 (Enclosure-IV).</p> <p>The university is registered with 29BN/UK/NCC, Dehradun with a waiting serial of 21.</p> <p>The University will take all necessary steps to expedite the process; which as it seems will take its due course of time.</p>
3.	<p>Entrepreneurship Development Cell activities to be enhanced</p>	<p>By imparting the essential traits of creativity, perseverance, confidence and ability to learn & listen for being a successful entrepreneur, the university envisages to create a dynamic entrepreneur. University's Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC) (Enclosure-V) has efficiently taken the mantle of grooming the students and has created a calendar of activities (Enclosure-VI) wherein eminent personalities/experts/entrepreneurs/CEO's/MD's of Start-ups will be invited for expert talk/discussion/workshop so as to ignite the entrepreneur in our students. Curriculum orientation in this direction has also been initiated.</p>

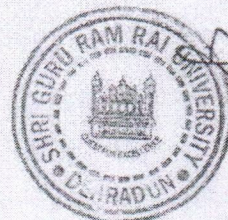
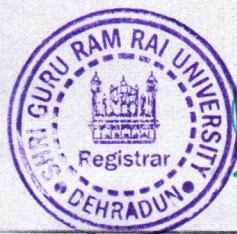

School of Management and Commerce Studies, School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, School of Computer Application and Information Technology, School of Basic & Applied Sciences. Annual Alumni meets have been organized (Enclosure- VIII). The association envisages to take 06 other Schools (Medical & Health Sciences, Nursing, Paramedical Sciences, Education, Agricultural Sciences, Humanities and Social Sciences) of University under its umbrella. An ambitious initiative in the form of "Alumni Lecture Series" is also underway wherein Alumni would share their experiences and success stories with their fellow students.</p>

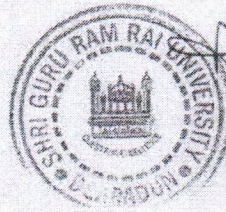
- University is in collaboration with Internshala which provides students an internship opportunity. Over 100 students of the University have secured internships for pan India locations.

Since efforts to increase University's visibility in the industry has been initiated by sending letters to more than 200 companies across the country seeking collaboration in

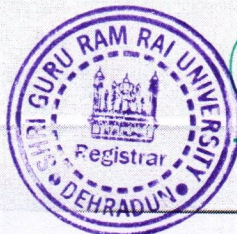
