#### (Duties and Responsibilities of Flying Squad)

- 1. The Flying Squad shall conduct themselves at the examination centre with utmost caution, courtesy and respect, without causing any kind of commotion, which shall disturb the examinees.
- 2. The Flying Squad shall not cause any kind of harassment either to the students or to any of the officials of the examination center.
- 3. The Flying Squad shall inspect the examination centre assigned by COE quickly, surprisingly and frequently preferably daily at different timings to ensure whether the arrangements made at different centers for the conduct of examinations are proper and adequate.
- 4. The Flying Squad shall initiate action to curb malpractice like copying, possession of in discriminatory materials related to the examinations.
- 5. After the inspection the Flying Squad will enter his observations in the end will submit the same along with consolidated report to COE after the examination is over.
- 6. The Flying Squad shall report the cases of malpractice detected to the CS for necessary action and subsequently inform the same to COE.
- 7. The Flying Squad shall carry out any other duties assigned by the COE from time to time for the smooth conduct of examinations and to curb the number of malpractice cases at any centre.
- 8. The Flying Squad shall not release any press statement under any circumstances.
- 9. The Flying Squad shall ensure utmost care to take the CS into confidence in the process of execution of his/ their duties and not to use improper language.
- 10. The Flying Squad shall not create unnecessary obstructions to the examinees by unnecessarily shouting while handling the cases in the examination halls. If any case is detected, further investigation can be done by isolating the guilty from the rest, taking into the CS office without further enquiring in the hall & disturbing the others for a prolonged period.
- 11. The Flying Squad may contact COE for any clarification/ guidance/ assistance whenever needed.
- 12. The Flying Squad to collect authorization letter from the COE before visiting examination centre.

# PUNISHMENT FOR ADOPTION OF UNFAIR MEANS IN EXAMINATION

Whenever a case of adoption of unfair means in an Examination is brought to the notice of the Controller of Examinations by an invigilator (through the Centre Superintendent) or by a Centre Superintendent, the Controller of Examinations shall take cognizance of the matter. The Controller of Examinations shall on every such occasion enquire into the matter and bring all incidents of unfair means in writing with relevant documents, wherever possible, to the Examination Disciplinary Committee constituted by the Vice Chancellor.

The constitution of the Examination Disciplinary Committee shall be as follows:

- (i) Dean/Professor of a Constituent College/ or their nominee Chairman
- (ii) Course Coordinator; and Hod Member
- (iii) Nominee of Office of Controller of Examinations Member Secretary

The Examination Disciplinary Committee may take further action under the following broad quidelines:

- A. (a) When incriminating material has been found in the possession of the examinee which was unrelated or related to the question paper but not copied and the student hands over the material when challenged and accepts the fault in writing, if directed to do so.
  - (b) When a student tries to copy from other Student's answer book, talks to other students, tries to exchange answer books/question papers/ calculators, tries to pass on information in any form and does accepts the fault in writing, when challenged.
- B. (a) When incriminating material related to the question paper has been found in the possession of an examinee he/she copied it in part or full or when the examinee refused to be searched, if so desired by the Center Superintendent/Invigilator.
  - (b) When a student tries to copy from other students' answer books, talks to other students, tries to exchange answer books/question papers/ calculators, or tries to pass on information in any form and does not accept the fault when challenged and/or enter into arguments with the invigilator(s).

#### Punishment to be awarded

A. Examination in that subject shall be cancelled. In the event of the unfair-means being adopted in an End-Semester Examination the student(s) may be allowed to clear the subject by appearing in the Supplementary Examination.

In the event of the unfair-means being adopted in a Supplementary Examination the student shall be declared failed in the Examination.

B. Examination in the subject as also in all other subjects of the semester shall be cancelled and the student shall be declared failed in all the subjects of the Semester.

In the event of the unfair-means being adopted in an End-Semester Examination to clear the semester by appearing examination in all the subjects.

However, in the event of the unfair-means being adopted in supplementary Examination.

D. When use of unfair-means has been attempted or where incriminating material has been found in the possession of the examinee, and the examinee has misbehaved with the faculty or staff on Examination supervision duty.	shall be cancelled and the student shall be expelled from the University.

Notwithstanding anything contained in the broad guidelines as above, the Board may, at its own discretion, award more severe punishment with or without imposition of a fine. When a fine is contemplated to be imposed, the Board shall decide the amount of the fine on a case to case basis. Board may also recommend rustication of the student from the rolls of the University, in case of repeated violation, or if student has a past history of other disciplinary violations or misconducts.

#### In case a student:

- is found lifting some other(s) work and inserting it in his/her project, seminar, dissertation etc. without proper acknowledgement, credit and reference or plagiarizing the dissertation/project report etc such penal action will be taken by the University as may be necessary to uphold the sanctity and integrity of the examination system and the credibility of the University.
- All such cases will be taken cognizance by the Examination Disciplinary Committee of the University. After giving an opportunity to the concerned student to explain the conduct/defend the charge, the Examination Disciplinary Committee shall take appropriate action including imposition of appropriate penalty including award of 'F' grade.

#### A) Appointment of Flying Squads →

- a. Flying Squads shall be appointed Controller of Examinations from a panel of names approved by the Vice-Chancellor.
- b. The members of the Flying Squads will be appointed from among the Officers and Faculty of the University who are Associate Professor or above with at least one female member in it. In case, female Associate Professor is not available then other senior faculty may be appointed for the same.
- c. The constitution of the flying squads will be kept confidential and members will be informed at short notice.
- d. The member of the Flying Squads shall makes their own arrangements for travel and shall not reveal details of their visits to anyone except their fellow members on the squad and Controller of Examinations.
