**Welcome Address:-**

The meeting began with a formal welcome address by the Chairman and the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, SGRR University and thereafter, the Chairman apprised the house regarding the overall development made by the University in the areas of Academic Advancement & Research. Some of the important features discussed are as follows:-

**First- To conduct the NAAC Accreditation and obtain A++ Rank:-** The Chairman informed the house that while submitting the SSR for NAAC Accreditation the progress report should be satisfactory so as to attain A++ rank in NAAC Accreditation. He also informed the house that NAAC PEER team had visit for the second time from 24<sup>th</sup> till 27<sup>th</sup> January and provided the valuable suggestion for putting collective effort to improve the grey areas.

**Second-** The University have made exquisite achievement in the field of Research & Development programmes by obtaining the projects from various outsources i.e. Govt/Non-Govt organization that are running in the University.

**Third- University Research achievement in terms of publications & Innovative Programmes:-** The Chair informed that the University is having 1400 publications for the last six years but after screening as per the norms of Scopus Generals/UGC care list and MOS



generals, the University is having good number of publications with high effect, and such type of number is approx 750. Further, he Congratulated Dean Research for his efforts in generating the fund of Rs.38 lakhs through the DST (Department of Science & Technology) project and directed all the Deans to motivate faculty members of their schools so that more such research projects from UGC/ICAR/UCOST) etc can be obtained which will help in generating revenue. Thereafter, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor invited Dr. Ajay Kumar Khanduri, Registrar and Member-Secretary of Fee Committee of the SGRR University to conduct the proceedings of the meeting.

Initiating the business of the day, the Registrar started the proceedings.

(b) <b>In Annexure 1- Agenda 3</b> The Committee informed that Fees of M.Sc RIT & M.Sc Optometry has not been decided yet by the Management as recommended by the Dean.
2.	<b>To consider the Action Taken Report on the Minutes of 7<sup>th</sup> Meeting of Fee Committee held on 24<sup>th</sup> December, 2022.</b>	(a) <b>Annexure 2- point 3</b> The Committee informed that the Fees Structure of New Courses has been implemented from Academic Session 2022-2023 onwards. (b) <b>Annexure 2-point 4</b> The Committee informed that the decision of increased in Fees Structure by the management on recommendation of Deans had been implemented from the Academic Session 2022-2023. (c) <b>Annexure 2-point 5</b> – The Committee informed that proposal to charge Alumni fee of Rs 500 from all the students at the time of awarding degree is successfully implemented. (d) The Committee suggested that students of MBBS/MD/MS who passed from HNBGU can also contribute in our Alumni Association funds voluntary. Therefore list should be provided of all Medical/Paramedical & Nursing students to President of Alumni Association for raising funds. (e) The Committee suggested conducting the Get-Together & Seminar of the Alumni for engaging their involvement and taking their suggestion for the progress of the University. (f) The Committee also suggested that on the day of Convocation we can provide the facility by opening the registration counter and the Alumni can get them registered on the spot. (g) The Committee informed the House that the all the expenses related to Alumni Association will be bear


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		from Alumni Association funds and yearly Audit will be conducted. (h) The Committee also decided to charge the Alumni fee taken at the time of Award of Fees.
3.	<b>To consider and approve Fee Structure of New Courses being started from Academic Session 2023-24 onwards.</b>	(a)The courses pass in Academic Committee i.e. B.Sc in Nutrition & B.Sc in Dietetics will be considered under Home Science Dept. and B.Sc in Holistic Wellness will come under Yogic Science Dept. therefore, the fee structure will be provided by the Deans of School of Humanities & Social Sciences.
4.	<b>To consider and approve the revised Fee Structure of existing courses of SGRR University from Academic Session 2023-24 onwards.</b>	(a)The Committee after the thorough discussion with the members present and on the recommendation of the deans decided the fees structure of the various courses (Except Medical/Paramedical/Nursing) of the University and placed it as the <b>Annexure 4</b> for kind consideration & approval. <b>Note:</b> - As suggested by the Committee the Fees Structure of the Various Courses passed in Fee Committee will be subject to review at the Time of Admission.
5.	<b>To consider and approve the Fee Concession policy for the Academic year 2023-2024. (Annexure 5)</b>	(a) <b>Annexure 5 point no 4-</b> It was decided in the meeting to raise the amount of scholarship of students of SGRR Institutes/Colleges taking admission from U.G to P.G courses from 10000 to 15000 so as to boost up the admission in our various P.G courses. (b) <b>Annexure 5 point no 6-</b> The Committee review the Scholarship provided to Meritorious Students and it was decided to provide the Scholarship on followings % slabs: 1- 95% & above – Scholarship of Rs 10000 to be provided. 2- 90% and below 95%- Scholarship of Rs 8000 to be provided. 3- above 80% and below 90%- Scholarship of Rs 5000 to be provided. (c) <b>Annexure 5 point no 8:-</b> The Committee decided that Scholarship on BPL card will be provided to only EWS(Economically Weaker Section) based on certificate issued by the Competent Authority i.e. D.M/S.D.M/Tehsildar only along with the income certificate.
