Dr. Arun Kumar (Dean-Research) welcomed & thanked Honorable Vice Chancellor Prof. P.P. Dhyani, for attending the fifth Research Committee meeting. Honorable Vice Chancellor welcomed all the members and enlightened all with his valuable inputs on

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the development of research environment in all ten schools of the university. He said research should be based on demand/value addition & sustainable development of new knowledge for the welfare of the nation/society.

Dean Research informed the house that Plagiarism Detection Software (PDS) will be received very soon from UGC. In general, case, UGC provides this software to 12b recognized universities only. However, our proposal was accepted by UGC, submitted on 11/07/2019 with the permission of Honorable Vice Chancellor.

Honorable Vice Chancellor also discussed five things that research should be focused on:

- 1) Demand
- 2) Innovation
- 3) New Knowledge
- 4) New things
- 5) Sustainable development


He shared his clear directions to all deans that the proper documentation of PG research/dissertation should also be maintained by Departmental Research Committee (DRC). Prof. P.P Dhyani further shared that medical college doctors can play a crucial role in the development of inter disciplinary research culture in the university by registering only one Ph.D research scholar with them because they very well know day to day challenges about the diseases and it could be most effective tool to generate alternative therapies being situated in very rich Himalayan biodiversity region.


**The following agenda items were discussed in the meeting:**

**Agenda 1:** To consider confirmation of minutes of 4<sup>th</sup> Research Committee meeting held on 19/02/2019.

It was informed to all members that the Minutes of the meeting of Research Committee of Shri Guru Ram Rai University, held on 19<sup>th</sup> February 2019, have been duly circulated to all via email on 18/03/2019 & no inputs were received. Dean-Research, Dr Arun

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Kumar presented the gist of the proceedings of the 4<sup>th</sup> Research Committee meeting along with the follow up action. Dr. Kumud Saklani suggested that Head of the department of respective school should be included in Synopsis Approval Committee (SAC), all members of the house agreed upon it.

New Synopsis Approval Committee (**SAC**) Composition:

- a) Dean/ Dean I/C of concerned School (**Chairperson**)
- b) Dean-Research (member)
- c) External expert (a Professor from outside the university)
- d) Research supervisor/s (member/s)
- e) Head of the department of respective discipline/subject**

The members reviewed the minutes thoroughly and expressed satisfaction on rest of the follow up action initiated by Dean-Research.

**Resolution:** The minutes of 4<sup>th</sup> Research Committee Meeting were unanimously confirmed by the house.


**Agenda 2:** To consider the development of Research Infrastructure of the University.



Prof. (Dr.) Bhaskar Charana Kabi and all other members of the committee also supported his views on the same line and told that some part of academic fee of the students should be fixed for it.

**Agenda 3:** To consider the allotment of Research Scholars, Batch-III (2018-2021) to eligible Ph.D. supervisors of the University.

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
Dean-Research, placed the list of Ph.D supervisors along with the allotted research scholars for consideration before the honorable members of the research committee.

Further, Dean-Research also informed the house that the Supervisors were allotted based on:

1. Latest UGC regulations, 2016 (amended in 2018) and SGRR university Ph.D ordinance.
2. Due weightage to student's choice of supervisor as per UGC guidelines.

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
  
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
3. Supervisor's qualifications and seniority in that particular course/subject.
4. Supervisor's research area.
5. Availability of subject experts

A discussion ensued and Dr Kumud Saklani (Dean I/C, School of Basic and Applied Sciences) submitted before the house that research scholar's allotted should be on the basis of seniority of the faculty in the department and she also emphasized that interdisciplinary research activities should be promoted. Dean-Research informed the members that seniority in the particular subject/discipline has been considered while allotting research scholars (as per UGC regulation 2016, clause no.6.4). Dr. S.C Pachauri, Prof. G. Ramalakshmi, Dr. Suchit Kumar & Dr Narotam Sharma seconded this. All members agreed upon it. Dr. Arun Kumar also invited the expert views on this matter by external expert (Prof. J.P. Bhatt). Prof. J.P. Bhatt suggested that seniority should be considered in specific discipline/subject while allotting research scholars and research scholars should not be allotted those faculty members who have crossed the age of 57 years in case where the age of retirement is 60 years. In case of Medical Sciences, it depends upon the MCI guidelines on retirement. Honorable Vice Chancellor welcomes his views and directed to Dean-Research to follow it. Prof. J.P. Bhatt was also suggested that subject experts should be considered as Ph.D supervisor. He also suggested that there should be inter-disciplinary research in the university with main supervisor from core subject and co-supervisor from any other department/subject/discipline. All members appreciated it.

Dean-Research, further raised the query upon the supervisors those who had resigned his/her post (examples of Medical Biochemistry and Management department), allotted research scholar should be shifted to the next senior faculty member of the department of same discipline or not? All members agreed that research scholar should be shifted to the next senior faculty member of the department of same discipline and it should be reported in next research committee meeting.

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**Resolution:** It was unanimously resolved to approve the subject wise allotment list of Ph.D Supervisors.

**Agenda 5:** To consider the Progress Monitoring Committee (PMC) meetings schedule for all Ph.D. scholars of the University.

Dean-Research prepared & placed a timeline schedule for the meetings of PMC as under:

All the registered Research Scholars shall be required to submit to the Head, Place of Research, through their Research Supervisors, elaborate progress report every six months. If a Research Scholar fails to submit three reports consecutively, his/her registration shall be treated as cancelled.

The progress reports submitted shall be placed by the Head, Place of Research before the Progress Monitoring Committee (PMC) consisting of:


1. Dean-Research

3. The Research Supervisor/s


The Committee shall scrutinize the progress reports and prepare a brief statement on the progress of Research Scholars & submit to Dean-Research for record.

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


All members reviewed the status of the seats for their respective college and appreciated the same.

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
  
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
