Welcome Address:

In his introductory address, the Chair extended hearty welcome to all members present inside the hall as well as External members who were available online and added that their knowledge, views and experience in their respective fields will be beneficial for the progress of the University.

Thereafter, the Chair briefed the members about the progress made by the University since last meeting of the Council held on 9th November, 2019. In this regard, he made a brief progress report of University since it came into existence in the year 2017. Recently, MCI has accorded sanction for M.CH Programme in Neurosurgery. Approval of MD/MS programmes in three more disciplines is in pipeline. From this academic session School of Engineering will be functional in which B. Tech Programmes in Computer Science Engineering, Civil Engineering and Agricultural Engineering are being introduced. He stressed the need that this year the

Management has set a target of 5000 admissions in various UG/PG courses. He emphasized that both School of Agricultural Sciences and School of Pharmaceutical Sciences should put in special efforts for the development of 'Centre of Excellence'. He further emphasized that School of Agricultural Sciences needed expansion, as some 80 acres of land is available nearby Patharibagh premises. He stressed upon quality publications by faculty members, especially senior ones. He said that the University should follow UGC norms on research, ratio, etc. and added that Dean Research should monitor research activities through software already purchased to augment such activities.

Thereafter, the Chair introduced Dr. Deepak Sahni as a Registrar who also happens to be the Member-Secretary of the Academic Council to conduct the proceedings of the meeting. Initiating the business of the day, the Registrar started the proceedings.

Agenda -1: To confirm the of Minutes of 4th Meeting of Academic Council held on 9th November, 2019. (Annexure-1)

The Minutes of the meeting of 4th Academic Council of Shri Guru Ram Rau University, held on 9th November, 2019 were placed before the house for confirmation.

The Member Secretary presented the gist of the proceedings of the Fourth Academic Council. The members reviewed the minutes thoroughly and expressed satisfaction.

Resolution: The house unanimously confirmed the Minutes of the meeting of 4th Academic Council held on 19th November, 2019.

The Action Taken Report was subjected to scrutiny before the house. All members expressed their appreciation towards the action initiated and steps taken.

Agenda -3: To consider and approve the student intake in various programs for the Academic session 2020-21. (Annexure 3)

Registrar presented before the house student intake in various programs across all the programs offered by the University for academic session 2020-21.

Resolution: The members of the house resolved to approve the sanctioned student intake in various programs as presented before the house.

Agenda-4: To Consider and approve curriculum and syllabus of various courses. (Annexure-4)

As per provisions of the University Statutes, meetings of Board of Studies were conducted by — (i) School of Pharmaceutical Sciences for B.Pharm, Pharm D, Pharm.D (PB), M.Pharm. (PP, Pharmaceutics, Pharmacology, PQA, Pharmacognosy & Pre Ph.D. courses; (ii) School of

Agriculture Sciences B.Sc.(Hons) Horticulture, B.Sc.(Hons)Agriculture, M.Sc.-Agronomy, M.Sc. Seed Science and Technology, M.Sc.-Social Science, M.Sc.-Plant Pathology, M.Sc.-Entomology courses; (iii) School of Basic & Applied Sciences for M.Sc.-Mathematics, Ph.D. Mathematics, Ph.D.-Chemistry; (iv) School of Humanities & Social Sciences for B.A./M.A.-Home Science, BAJM.A.-Music(Vocal & Instrumental), B.A.-Garhwali Folk Language and Folk Culture, M.A.(Economics). In addition, School Paramedical Sciences conducted 2nd BOS for various UG/PG) courses.

Resolution: The curriculum and syllabus of the various courses as recommended by the respective Board of Studies were resolved to be approved in toto.

The Chair has directed that an expert committee be formed to look into the matter.

Resolution: The house unanimously accepted the suggestion.

The Chairman, Prof. (Dr.) U.S Rawat, provided an overview to the members of the existing value added programs at the university and requested input from attendees on the various additions proposed programs.

Resolution: It was resolved to be approved in toto.

Agenda -8: To consider the Report on University Examination held from November, 2009 till 30th June, 2020. (Annexure- 7)

The Examination Report (10/11/2019 to 06/06/2020) was placed before the house. The Chair informed the members that examinations, including Pre- Ph.D. ESE, were conducted 10 times by the University in the period of last 08 months after the last academic council meeting which was held in November, 2019. This is by all means an excellent achievement for a newly established University.

Resolution: Examination Report of the University was resolved to be approved.

Agenda -9: To consider and approve the minutes of University Examination Committee meeting held from 1st June, 2020.

The meeting was necessitated to consider the UGC Guidelines in view of the countrywide lockdown imposed by Government of India due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

The members gone through the details and appreciated the prompt action taken by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Sir modifying the existing progression policy as per UGC guidelines.

- Remuneration for Internal Examiners and Evaluators. The Chair directed that documentary proof from other Private Universities be produced in this regard.

Any other Items:

- The external members agreed to the agenda points and Mr. Gaurav Lamba said that industry tie ups should be made and industry-student interaction should be enhanced.
- Or. Rashmi Gaur is of the opinion that a committee can be constituted under MOOCS to substitute the credits of the courses done by students relevant to their field of specialization. She is also of the opinion that the future BOS should be linked with industry and syllabus should be designed accordingly.
- Prof. Vijay Rai is of the opinion that coding job has ample opportunity in India and a six month Diploma/certificate courses can be started later on. He is also of the opinion that food processing industry also has major job opportunity in future for which a course can be started.
