#### Welcome Address:-

The meeting began with a formal address by Honourable Vice Chancellor, Chairman of the Finance Committee, Dr. U.S. Rawat. He welcomed all the members for their participation in the fifthFinance Committee meeting and presented the highlights of progress of the last one year since the last meeting that was held on 7<sup>th</sup>December 2020:

- (i) Hon. Sir told the house about the good number of admission which took place in our university i.e. approx 2450, beside School of Medical and Health Sciences, School of Paramedical Sciences, and School of Nursing during the Academic year 2021-22.
- (ii) He told that the SMIH (Shri Mahant Indiresh Hospital) got the 1<sup>st</sup> position in Uttarakhand and 18<sup>th</sup> position in north India as per the report published in India Today September, 2021 issue.
- (iii) Copy of the Fourth Annual Reportwas placed before the house.
- (iv) Compilation of the Fourth Annual Accounts and Audit Report for Financial Year 2020-21 as per the provisions of University Acts and Statutes.

(v) The 12 B status Report has been finalized and submitted to an External expert for his valuable suggestions and inputs.

(vi) The NCC male unit has been applied by the university and the approval for the same

has also been received.

(vii) The faculty member's of the University has also filed 3 Patents in different areas of specialization and the approval for which is yet to be received.

(viii) The examinations of First semester will be conducted via online mode for various courses due to the spread of third wave of COVID-19 Pandemic.

(ix) More than 50 faculties were recruited in different subjects and the appointments were made strictly as per eligible criteria of regulatory bodies.

Thereafter, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor invited MemberSecretary to conduct the proceedings of the meeting. Initiating the business of the day, the Chief Finance Officerstarted the proceedings.

Agenda -1: Confirmation of Minutes of Fourth Meeting of Finance Committee held on 7th December, 2020.

The Minutes of the meeting of FourthFinance Committee of Shri Guru Ram Rai University, held on7<sup>th</sup> December, 2020, were placed before the house for confirmation.

MemberSecretary, Shri Ashok Swami, Chief Finance Officer, SMIH presented the summary of the proceedings of the FourthFinance Committee. The members reviewed the minutes thoroughly and expressed satisfaction and accorded confirmation.

<u>Resolution:</u> The house unanimously confirmed the Minutes of the meeting of FourthFinance Committee held on 7<sup>th</sup> December, 2020.

Agenda -2: Action Taken Report on the Minutes of 4<sup>th</sup> meeting of Finance Committee held on 7<sup>th</sup> December, 2020.

The Action Taken Report was subjected to scrutiny before the house. The decision which was taken in the fourth finance committee meeting i.e. to provide 35% concession to the ward of SGRR University will not be generalized and will be given on case to case basis. All members expressed their appreciation for the actions initiated and steps taken.

<u>Resolution:</u> The house expressed satisfaction on the action taken report on the minutes of the last Finance Committee held on 7<sup>th</sup> December, 2020.

Agenda -3: Consideration and approval of Annual Accounts, Balance Sheet and Audited Report for Financial Year 2020-21 of the University.

Honorable Vice Chancellor requested Member Secretary, Shri Ashok Swami, Chief Finance Officer, to present the Annual Accounts and Audit Report for FY 2020-21 of the University who gave a PowerPoint presentation on the Income & Expenditure Statement and the Balance Sheet of SGRR University. Heinformed the house that the University earned a surplus of Rs.

40.83 Crores against the surplus of Rs. 48.58 crores in the last financial year. The year witnessed a decrease of nearly 16.1% in surplus compared to last year because of the Covid -19 pandemic.

Resolution: The house unanimously resolved to approve the Annual Accounts & Audited Reportfor FY 2020-21 of the University.

#### NB:

- Only one concession/discount can be availed by a candidate.
- No two concession/discount can be clubbed.
- \* (a) The scholarship is available only to those candidates who have participated in the sports during the last three years.
  - (b) All the documents provided by the candidate for sports scholarship are required to be verified by the Sports Officer-SGRRU with the comment about the Sports Quota (i.e. National, School State Medalist, District School Medalist etc).
- (iii) Fee Concession to the Wards of University Staff was also deliberated upon and it was the directions of the management that fee concession to the wards of university staff will be given on case to case basis and not as a matter of policy.

#### Any other Item:

- (i) Dr. H.S. Sharma, OSD, SGRR Education Mission apprized the house that in SGRR Public School there is a policy that if the earning member of the student expires during the course of study, then 100% concession in Tuition Fees is given to him/her for that Semester/Year of study. The same policy may also be implemented in the university with the approval of Competent Authority.
- (ii) Hon. Vice Chancellor Sir also suggested that the number of copies of Annual Report to be printed for the next year onwards should be at least 100.
- (iii) Budgetary estimates should be prepared by each School and budgets should be allocated under each head of expenditure so that sanctioning can be made accordingly.
